

We clean up litter and debris that has either been left behind or washed up on shore. It is a necessity to remove these items from the beach to ensure the wild horses are not harmed or injured. In the past, we have collected a lot of balloons, washed up boats, vehicle parts, lawn chairs and so much more.

Meet up is 9 A.M. at Mile Post 22 on Corova Beach. From there, we will spread out and clean up the beach and back roads of Corova. At noon, we will all gather back at Mile Post 22 for raffle prizes and lunch. In the past, we have had lunch on the Beach provided by the VA4WDA. Unfortunately, we are unable to serve the volunteers this year due to NC State Regulations regarding COVID-19. We are in the process of coming up with an alternative plan for lunch. 








MPJAI Update




